

UPDATE ON OUR GRACE BRETHREN FAMILY IN HAITI

HAITI - PRAY for our brothers and sisters in these days of uncertainty, distress, and grief. These items are taken from several emails recieved from Dr. Chuck Davis yesterday and today:

- Yvonne Volvo is one of our valuable staff members in Cap Haitian. We received word that her little sister who was in Port Au Prince died during the quake. Pastor Joseph went to Port Au Prince to claim the body of Yvonne's sister but discovered that she had been buried in the mass grave of 7,000 people.
- Yolette, Pastor Elysee Joseph's wife, received news that her niece, who was attending college in Port Au Prince, died in the quake in Port Au Prince.
- Pastor Herlin's brother, Watson, and Herlin's sister and baby have been found and are safe.
- The damage from the quake in Cap Haitian (where the majority of the Grace Brethren work is) to structures and people is very minor. For that we PRAISE GOD!
- Pastor Elysee Joseph will be leaving Haiti as soon as we can arrange passage. PRAY for him as he is exhausted. He has been in Haiti since the middle of December. The sights he saw have made an everlasting impression on him.
- Continue to PRAY for the Haitian people. PRAY that many will come to know Jesus as Savior and Lord during this time. That is the only thing that will truly change Haiti.
